Completed applications should be turned in to PSHS School Counselor, Mrs. Ericka Mabry, no later than 3:00 pm Friday March 31, 2023. Late applications will NOT be accepted. Scholarships will be awarded at the school's Senior Awards Night.

Eligibility Requirements

- Student must be a graduating senior at PSHS
- Student must have participated as an athlete in a JV or varsity sport at PSHS. (Must be a sport recognized by BCSD and SCSHL and not a club.)
- Student **OR** Student's Parent/Guardian must be a member of the Iron Horse Gameday Club prior to February 28, 2023.
- Student must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher on the South Carolina Uniformed Grading Scale.
- Student must plan to attend a 2- or 4-year college or technical school.
- Out-of-school Suspension (OSS) during the 2022-2023 school year will eliminate an applicant.
- In-school Suspension (ISS) will be reviewed on a per case basis.
